Tour of Scotland

Day 1 Saturday October 18	USA to Scotland. Depart USA for overnight flight to Scotland. Dinner is served aloft.
Day 2 Sunday October 19	Glasgow. Morning arrival at Glasgow Airport where, after clearing Customs, we meet our Professional Scottish Driver Guide and Hammond Tours Staff. The history of Glasgow, Scotland's largest city is rich and diverse. In its 1400 years Glasgow has been a religious community, a salmon fishing village, a medieval university town, a major centre of trade with North America and the second city of the British Empire, famed for its shipbuilding and engineering. We enjoy a panoramic tour of this town. Dinner and overnight Novotel Glasgow Center
Day 3 Monday October 20	Glasgow. It is on to famous Stirling Castle. Stirling Castle is the grandest of Scotland's castles and one of the most popular visitor attractions in the country. 250 feet above the plain on an extinct volcano, Stirling became the strategic military key to the kingdom during the 13th and 14th century Wars of Independence and was the favorite royal residence of many of the Stuart Monarchs. Many important events from Scotland's past took place at Stirling Castle, including the violent murder of the eighth Earl of Douglas by James II in 1452. Stirling Castle played an important role in the life of Mary Queen of Scots. She spent her childhood in the castle and Mary's coronation took place in the Chapel Royal in 1543. Dinner and overnight Novotel Glasgow Center
Day 4 Tuesday October 21	Glasgow-Lochness. This morning you will depart for the Highlands first travelling up the west bank of Loch Lomond, you will see some spectacular views of the Loch and get the chance to stop for photographs. Continue north through Crianlarich and across Rannoch Moor to the most scenically beautiful of all Highland glens, Glencoe. Travel over the Ballachulish bridge and on to Fort William, passing Ben Nevis, the UK's highest mountain. We enjoy a 1 hour Lochness Cruise. On the cruise we pass the historic ruins of Urquhart Castle where you will get the best photographs of the castle along with a comprehensive commentary on the history of the castle. Dinner and overnight Mackay's Hotel
Day 5 Wednesday October 22	Skye. Full day Skye Excursion. We visit Dunvegan Castle and the island's main town of Portree and pass the spectacular Cuillin Hills of Skye. Return to Lochness. Dinner and overnight Mackay's Hotel
Day 6 Thursday October 23	Lochness-Edinburgh. A leisurely start this morning will take you south through the mountains of the Cairngorms National Park. Your route takes you over the Drumochter Pass (1500ft above sea level). Travel through the Highland resort town of Pitlochry, built on Victorian tourism. Continue south towards Perth to Scone Palace the crowning place of Scottish Kings, now the cherished family home of the Earl of Mansfield. In the extensive grounds of Scone Palace there is a replica of the Stone of Destiny and the chapel on Moot Hill where the coronations took place. Dinner and overnight Edinburgh Mercure Princess Street
Day 7 Friday October 24	Edinburgh. Today we suggest taking a ½ day sightseeing tour of Edinburgh. Learn all about the history of Edinburgh including the Scottish Parliament, Edinburgh Castle, John Knox House, Greyfriars Bobby, St. Giles Cathedral, Holyrood Palace, the Museum of Scotland, Royal Museum, Jenners, Victoria Street Shopping, Princes Street Gardens, the Scott Monument and more. Dinner and entertainment at Jamie's Scottish Evening. Overnight Mercure Princess Street
Day 8 Saturday October 25	Edinburgh-USA. Morning departure for Edinburgh Airport and our flight home. Arrive home the same day!
